**DECISION OF THE GOVERNING BOARD ON THE EXTENSION OF THE
MEDIUM-TERM PRIORITIES 2012-14 UNTIL END OF 2016**

Having regard to:

- the decision of the Governing Board of 25 April 2014 on the extension of the medium-term priorities 2012-14 for one more year until 2015;
- the proposal by the Bureau at its meeting on 8 and 9 December 2014 to extend the current medium-term priorities for another year until December 2016;
- the ongoing review of the Europe 2020 strategy for smart, sustainable and inclusive growth;
- the ongoing mid-term review of ET 2020, the strategic framework for European cooperation on education and training and within this process the ongoing consultations on defining priorities and short-term deliverables for European VET policy under the Bruges communiqué;
- the new Financial Regulation which obliges Cedefop to prepare a 'single programming document' to be adopted by the Governing Board by 31 January 2016 which consists of multiannual programming, the annual work programme for 2017 and the draft budget;
- the parallel processes to be handled efficiently and smoothly;

Whereas,

- the medium-term priorities 2012-14 provide a framework sufficiently broad to cover Cedefop's activities until end 2016;
- the medium-term priorities will be replaced by multiannual programming in 2016;
- it is within the Governing Board's competence to adopt Cedefop's medium-term priorities;



THE GOVERNING BOARD OF CEDEFOP HAS DECIDED AS FOLLOWS:

Article 1

Cedefop's medium-term priorities 2012-14 extended in April 2014 to 2015 shall be further extended until end of 2016 and thus will also provide the framework for the work programme 2016.

Article 2

This decision shall enter into force on the date of its signature.
