The trainee will research the market and propose solutions. The second part of the project will be to contribute to maintaining high ICT security in Cedefop.</p>
The trainee's main duties and tasks	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Monitor all issues and actions related to ICT security ➤ Be part of the business continuity team and work with the state of all the BCP (Business Continuity Plan) procedures and equipment as well as the DRS (Disaster Recovery Site) equipment and network, ➤ Administration of Jira ➤ Installation of demo versions and hands-on trials of various software/tools, ➤ Programming/customising, ➤ Drafting of feasibility studies and tools assessments, ➤ Presentations to ICT staff
