Short description	Employers with less than 250 employees in North Rhine-Westphalia can apply for the state funded grant (voucher system). Only job-related education and training activities are eligible. The grant is co-financed by the ESF. The co-funding share is 50% of the costs for education and training (max 500 EUR). There is no preferential treatment. Re-use is possible each calendar year. An employer can receive up to ten voucher per year (yet not more than one per employee). A corresponding voucher is available for individuals.
