Short description	Based on a collective agreement, employers of the construction sector contribute to a training fund and receive subsidies for their training costs from the fund. EU-funds support the training fund (50% of the fund's budget, approx. EUR 3 000 000). The remaining EUR 3 000 000 are raised through the levy on companies in the sector (0.65% of the payroll). Professional education and training, research, and development in the building sector are considered eligible types of training. No preferential treatment for particular eligible groups is applied.
