<b>Short description</b>	Based on a collective agreement, employers of the construction sector contribute to a training fund and receive subsidies for their training costs from the fund. EU-funds support the training fund (50% of the fund's budget, approx. EUR 3 000 000). The remaining EUR 3 000 000 are raised through the levy on companies in the sector (0.65% of the payroll). Professional education and training, research, and development in the building sector are considered eligible types of training. No preferential treatment for particular eligible groups is applied.

The IFSB has expanded its range of sustainability-oriented training courses and thus offers training adapted to all sectors of activity. The IFSB has also expanded its training offer dedicated to management staff and now offers training in the fields of finance, human resources and communication.
