Background

A comprehensive reform of the vocational training system for employment under the labour remit started in 2015 (Law 30/2015 of 9 September and Royal Decree 694/2017 of 3 July). The reform of the common administrative procedure of public administrative authorities (Law 39/2015 of 1 October) and of the legal regime of the public sector (Law 40/2015) introduced, among other changes, electronic processing in public administration management.

Objectives

The State registry of training providers of the vocational training system for employment (*Registro Estatal de Entidades de Formación del sistema de formación profesional para el empleo en el ámbito laboral*) is conceived as an instrument of transparency and dissemination of the integrated information system to improve coordination and inter-administrative cooperation in the training for employment system.

Description

Order TMS/369/2019 harmonises the system of accreditation of all training providers. All vocational training providers authorised by the different competent authorities are integrated into one network through the State registry, which also ensures coherence with the Catalogue of training specialities (associated or not with professional certificates). The registry is used by the employment authorities to manage different services for different target groups. Only registered providers may receive public funds for running training programmes. The new system aims to foster the coordination of training activities (face-to-face, digital or blended training) in line with the common employment services' portfolio and protocols.

2019 Approved/Agreed

The registry is to be updated, in real time, by the State public employment service (SEPE) and coordinated with those available at regional level, sharing a common data structure. The measure is part of the common employment services portfolio aiming to

guarantee equal access to free public employment services across the country.

2020 Implementation

A computer system has been developed to support the State registry of training providers, as well as the interconnection systems and protocols of the regional registers authorised in this area. The system is currently being tested and is scheduled to be put into service in 2021.

2021 Implementation

The State registry of training providers is operational and runs as a regular practice.

2022 Completed

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In 2022, the computer system supporting the management of the Registry was completed. This application, whose development, maintenance and updating is carried out by the State Public Employment Service, enables the maintenance and consultation of the different training entities that are included in it, interconnecting the information with the records activated by the different competent labour administrations in their respective areas of management, as well as with the other corporate computer applications that support the management of actions within SEPE's competence, such as the catalogue of training specialities, the training management system or the common training data system, amongst others.
