Description

In November 2018, based on the work of the National Higher Vocational Education Council (Nasjonalt fagskolegrad), and following public consultation until September 2018, new degrees for post-secondary vocational education were introduced. The fagskolegrad (professional degree) is delivered after one-year of vocational school education (60 and 90 credits). The høyere fagskolegrad (higher professional degree) is delivered after two or three-year post-secondary vocational education (120-180 credits).

Law on higher vocational education

A law for post-secondary vocational education (EQF level 5) was adopted in 2018. Higher vocational colleges are categorised as post-secondary (referred to as tertiary in Norway) vocational education schools. Their students have strengthened rights.
