Description

This is a new pathway for acquiring trade and journeyman's certificates. It is targeted at low-skilled adults in employment. The distinctive principle of the scheme is to provide workers with upper secondary education and training while on-the-job, so they can continue earning their living. They are exempted from some of the core subjects and from part of the written test when applying for the certificate. The model was successfully piloted in five counties from 2011 to 2014 and then positively evaluated. The scheme was on public consultation in May 2017 and was implemented as a new national pathway in 2018.
