Objectives

The project will contribute to increasing the access of adults to different forms of lifelong learning through the development of model programmes for vocational qualification courses (*kwalitykacyjne kursy zawodowe - KKZ*) leading to a qualification, and vocational skills courses (*kursy umiejętności zawodowych - KUZ*).

Description

In January 2016, the education ministry opened a call for proposals to develop model programmes for vocational qualification courses (*kwalitykacyjne kursy zawodowe - KKZ*) for adults. The assessment of applications was finalised in late 2016; three projects were selected and began to be implemented. The initiative is co-financed by the ESF. The aim is to support VET providers in expanding their offer for adults. The projects were completed at the beginning of 2018, with 81 model vocational qualifications courses developed in the tourism, gastronomy, electric, electronic, administration and services areas.

2019 Implementation

The second part of this initiative started in 2019. A call for proposals for developing programmes for vocational qualifications courses and vocational skills courses was announced in the second half of 2019. As a result, four projects were selected.

In December 2019 an umbrella project evaluating the outputs of several projects (including the outputs of the aforementioned projects) was launched by the Centre for Education Development. It aimed to provide content-related supervision and evaluation of the products/ outputs of other projects for them to be approved and put into effect.

2020 Implementation

The implementation of the four selected projects continued. Under the umbrella project 223, model curricula of vocational qualification courses (KKZ) together with the curricula of vocational skills courses (KUZ) were approved after going through content-related evaluation.

2021 Completed

The project on developing vocational qualification courses (KKZ) and vocational skills courses (KUZ), as well as the umbrella project, were finalised in February 2021.

The umbrella project prepared 160 model programmes of vocational qualification courses and vocational skills courses. The beneficiary prepares information on professions using multimedia materials, virtual walks and additional functionalities.

The dissemination of the project's products will take place in 2022.
