Background

Strengthen the culture of cooperation between schools and the learners' parents.

Objectives

Giving parents their place in the education strategies implemented for the best possible future of children and young people.

Description

The Act of 1 August 2018 created a national representation of parents for minor learners in primary, secondary and differentiated education (*éducation différenciée*). The representation comprises four parents of learners from primary education, six parents of learners from secondary education (general and technical) and two parents of learners in differentiated education. The mission of the representation - either on its own initiative or on request of the Ministry - is to express an opinion on law projects or educational projects. It can also make proposals regarding school life and teaching.
