## Background

There was a need to make the education debate more objective.

## Objectives

This platform of discussion and reflection is meant to allow for a larger, continuous debate, independent of the political changes in the country.

## Description

The Ministry of Education, Children and Youth created in 2018 the Lëtzebuenger Bildungsdësch, a national conference on education, which includes all major stakeholders (scientific experts, civil society, etc) to shape the outlines of education priorities.

Several institutions took part in the conference.

- (c) Department for Coordination of Educational and Technological Research and Innovation (SCRIPT)
- (d) National Observatory of School Quality
- (e) National Programme Council

- (h) Competence centres for learners with special needs (Collège des centres de compétences)
