Description

As part of the Structural Reform Support Service (SRSS) of the European Commission to support job creation and sustainable growth, a project with OMNIA (the Finnish project partner) was carried out. The main focus was on:

- (a) developing a consultation process between the business world and VET in the region of Attica (the focus sector was construction);
- (b) developing a train-the-trainers model;
- (c) developing a guidebook for integrating key competences in VET curricula;
- (d) implementing learning outcomes in VET curricula;
- (e) capacity building for the implementation of the European credit system for vocational education and training (ECVET).

The project was completed in 2017.
