Description

A scheme called Students as apprentice teachers (*étudiants apprentis-professeurs*) was introduced in the 2015/16 school year, replacing a similar scheme called *Future jobs for teachers*. The scheme is designed for students from disadvantaged backgrounds who are at the start of their university studies and aiming to become teachers. In this respect they integrate a 3-year pre-professionalisation pathway from the second year of the Bachelor degree. During this training programme, participants are offered teaching opportunities with actual classes under the supervision of tutor-teachers, which will include observation time, collaboration with the tutor and teaching practice as gradual training for the teaching profession. The scheme is intended to enable students from disadvantaged backgrounds to be better prepared for the competitive teacher examination (*Concours d'accès au corps des professeurs de lycée professionnel, CAPLP*).

2019 Implementation The objectives pursued by this measure are now included in the initial training plan for teachers (the bill on the school of trust, <i>Ecole de la confiance</i>) on initial teacher training and CPD.
2020 Implementation The measures are operational and run as regular practice.
2021 Completed The measure is operational and runs as regular practice. This renovation of teacher training, promoted by the 2019 Law for a school of trust, is introduced as early as the

second year of the Bachelor degree for students planning to prepare for competitive examinations. It is a pre-professionalisation course enabling a gradual and remunerated entry into the teaching profession with professional support.
