

Commission staff working document on package of recommendations on digital skills in education

Working document accompanying the Proposals for a Council Recommendation on the key enabling factors for successful digital education and training and on improving the provision of digital skills in education and training

Description

The European Commission's working document provides an overview of the current state of digital education and skills in the European Union. It examines the enabling factors for digital education and training, including digital infrastructure, institutional capacity, and policy development and implementation. The document highlights the importance of digital skills and competencies today, and the need to address existing digital skills gaps. It also explores the provision of digital skills education from early childhood to adult learning, including the role of informatics and the need to address gender and representation gaps. The report aims to identify areas for improvement and future development in digital skills education, providing a foundation for policymakers and educators to build upon.

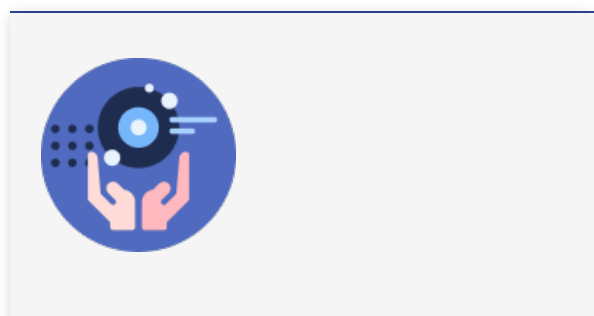
