Background

In line with the 2023–2028 coalition agreement, Luxembourg is committed to expanding its higher VET (formation professionnelle supérieure) offerings to provide a high-quality alternative to academic education by offering specialised training opportunities that are directly aligned with labour market needs.

Objectives

By creating structured progression pathways beyond initial VET, this new qualification level will allow VET learners to further develop their skills and access careers in strategic, high-demand fields such as finance, ICT, logistics, and engineering.

Description

The programmes are designed in close cooperation between the MENJE and the professional chambers, ensuring that training content is shaped by the real and evolving demands of employers.

2025 Design

The Ministry of Education, Children and Youth is currently working on a legal framework for Higher Professional Vocational Education and Training. In this context, it is consulting the professional chambers.
