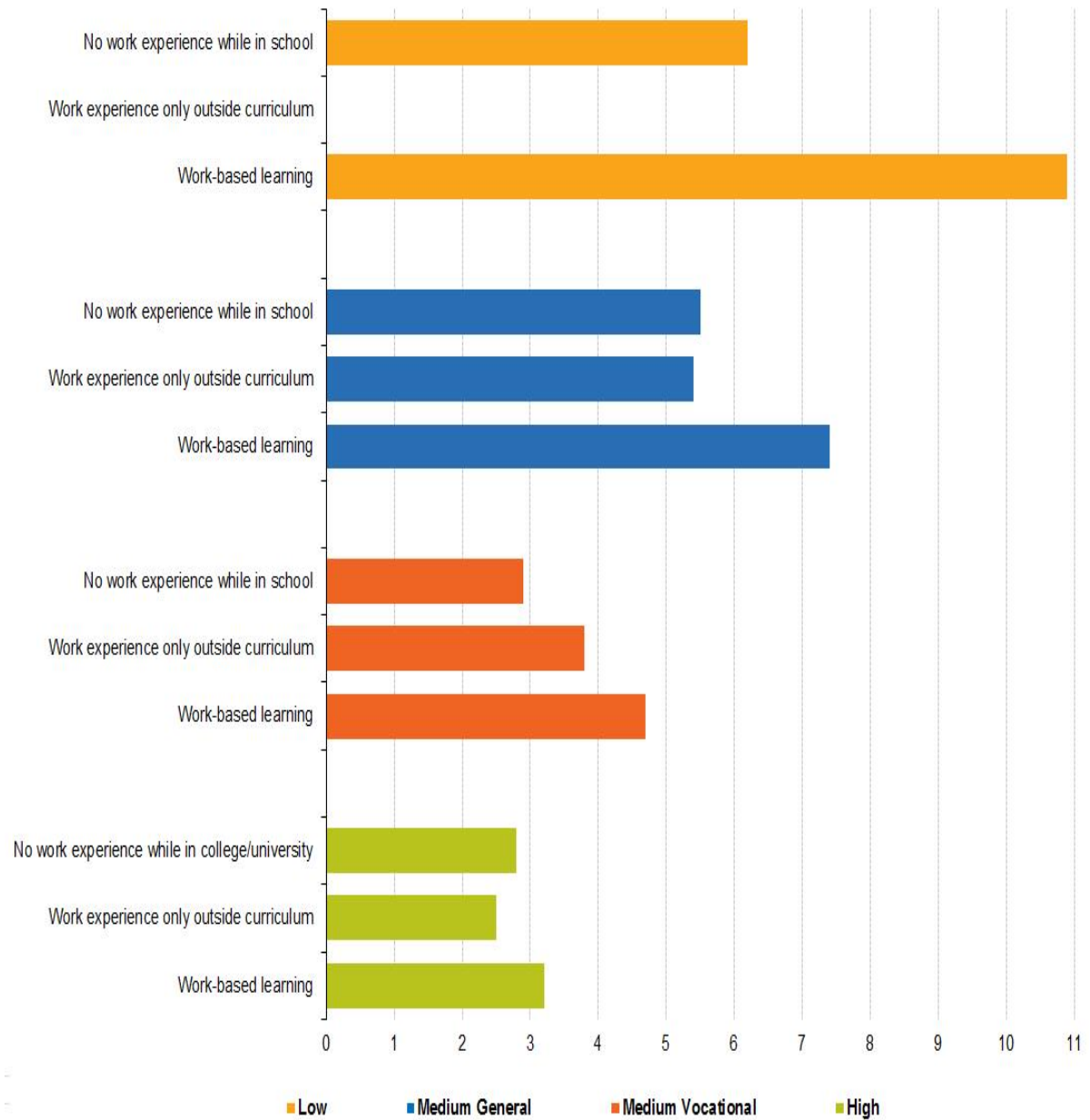


Completion of VET at a medium level of education leads to less precarious work than medium general training or lower education level

Description

The results for EU-28 show that there are fewer young people aged 20-34 in precarious work with completed medium vocational training (ISCED 3-4) than medium general training (ISCED 3-4) or lower education level (ISCED 0-2).
