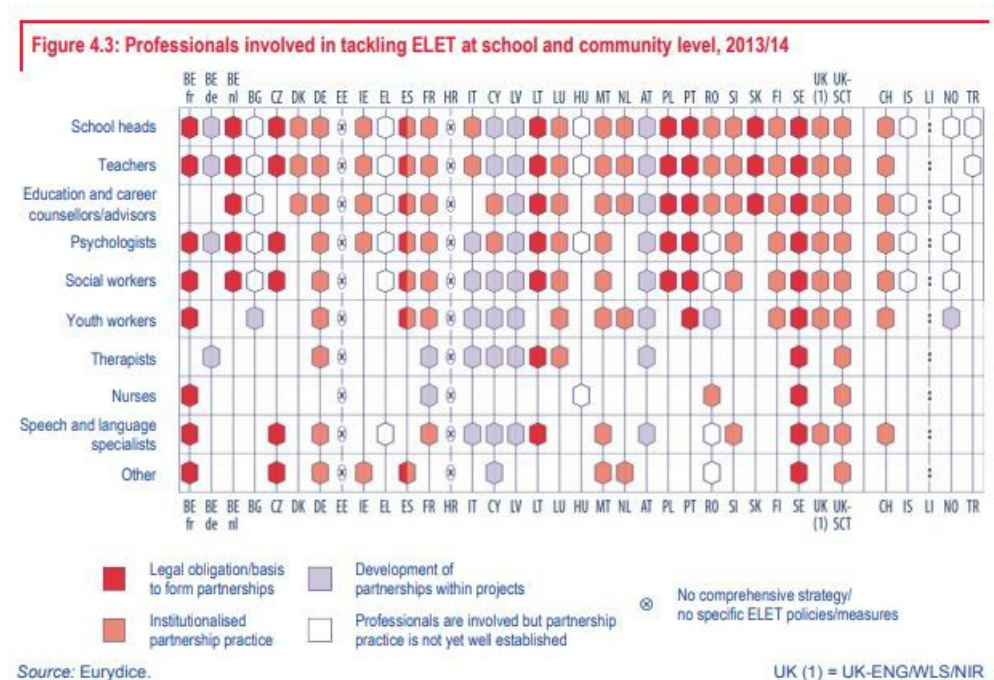


Professionals involved in tackling ELET at school and community level
