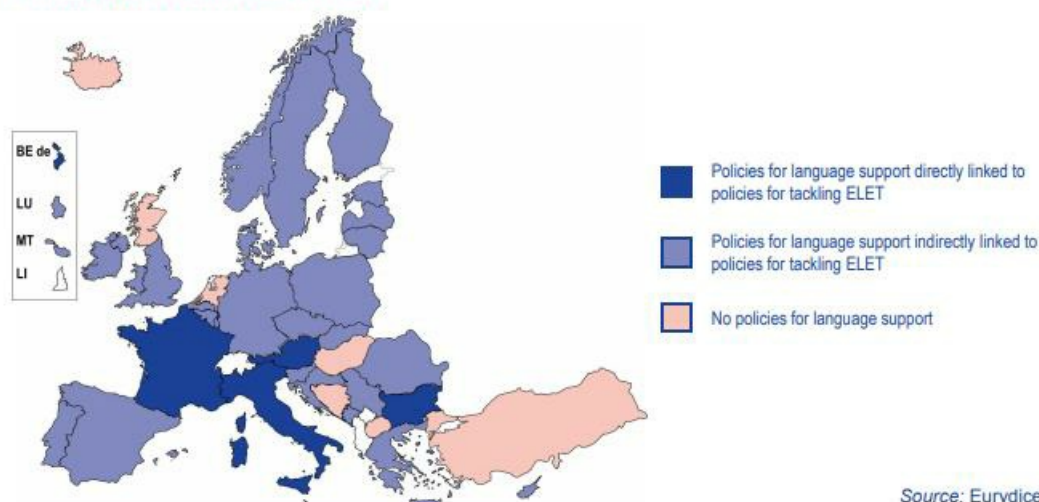


Links between ELET policies and language support policies for students whose mother tongue is other than the language of instruction

In most countries in Europe policies for language support for students whose mother tongue is other than the language of instruction is not directly linked to policies for tackling early leaving.


















Figure 3.3: Links between ELET policies and language support policies for students whose mother tongue is other than the language of instruction, 2015/16
