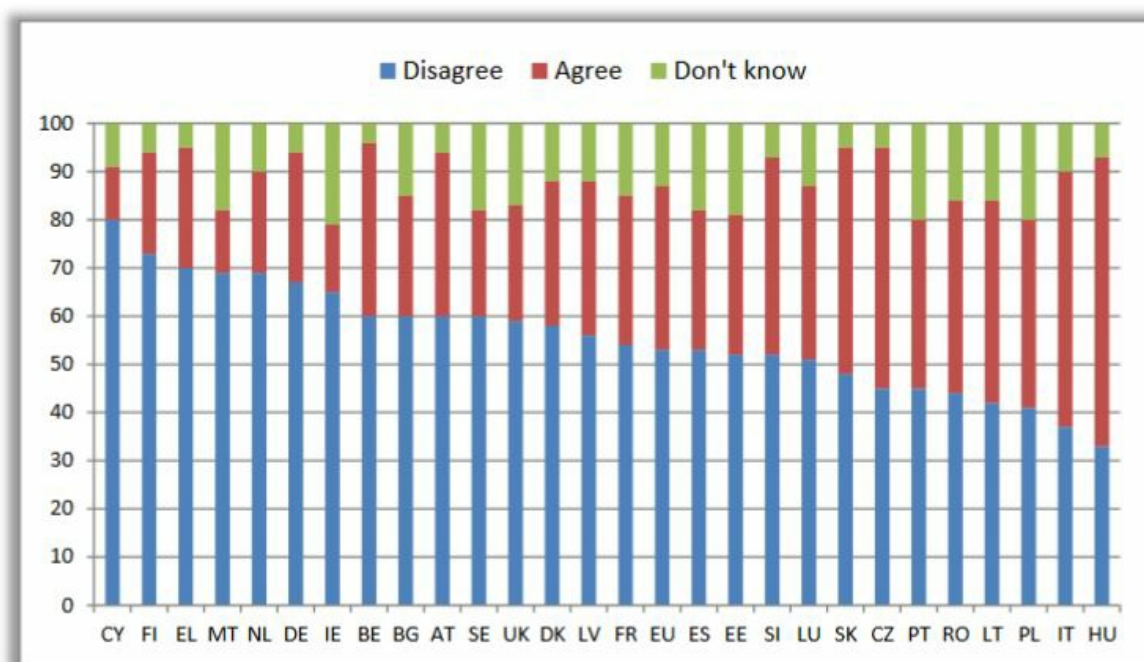


VET offers opportunities to develop communication and teamwork skills
