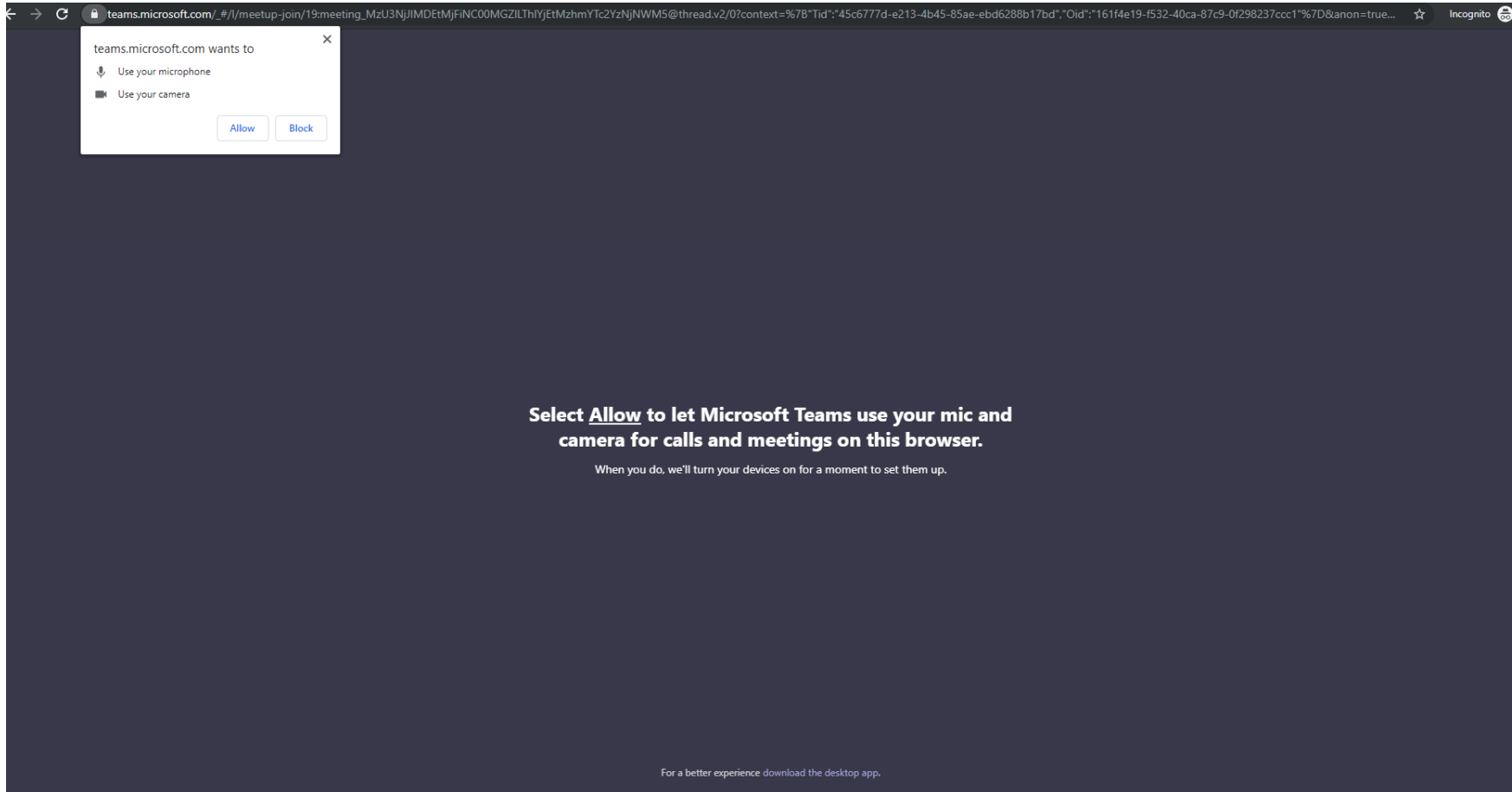

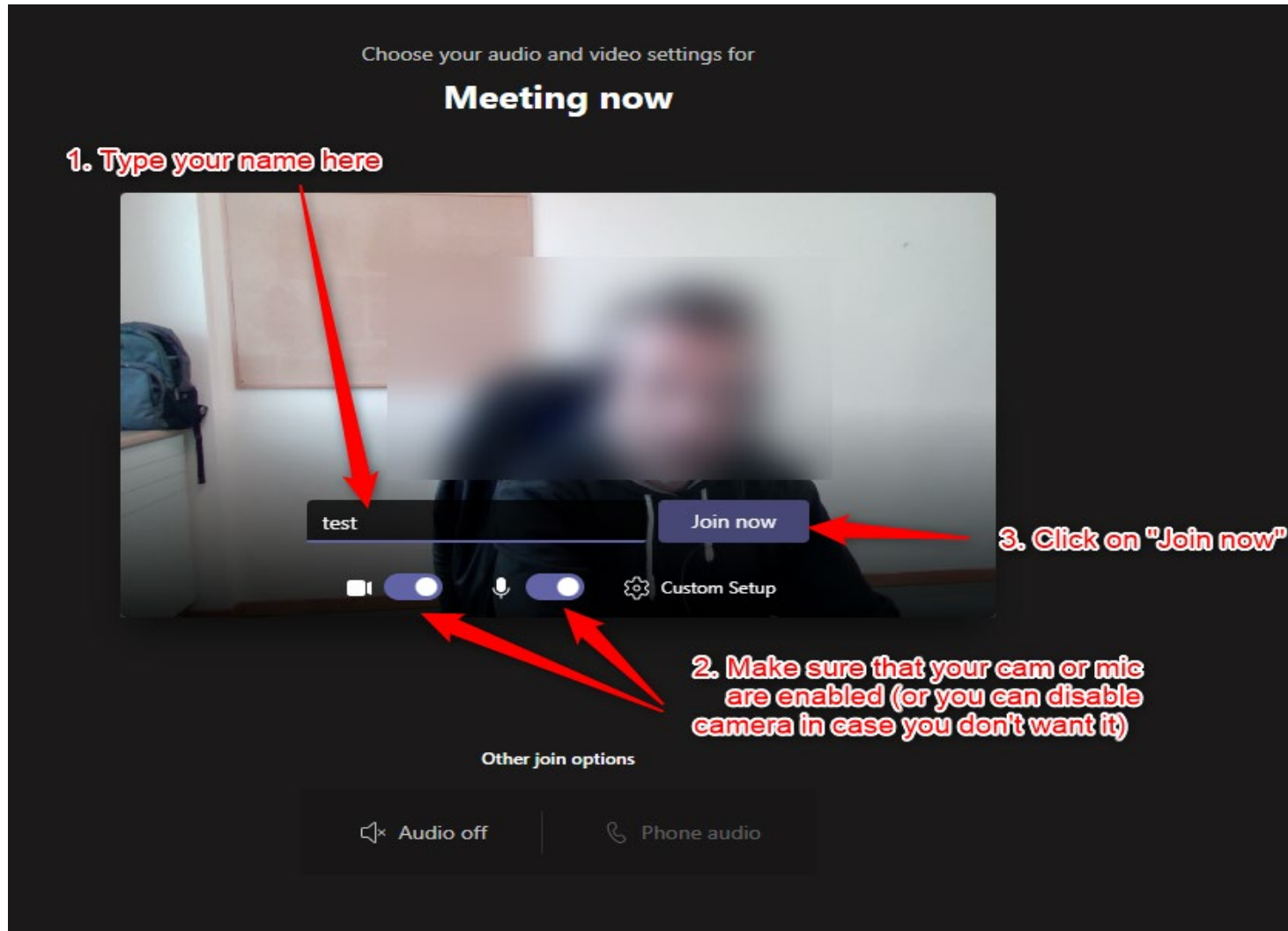

Type your **Name Surname (Institution)** in the relative text field, check your camera and microphone and then click on “Join now”  
Ex. Carmen Vega (Spanish Ministry of Employment)



After you click on “Join now” You will wait in the “Lobby” until the organizer joins you in.

You should then be connected!
