Negotiated Procurement Procedure for Curriculum Vitae (CV) data analytics & intelligence

Background

The European Centre for the Development of Vocational Training (Cedefop), located in Thessaloniki-Greece, is planning to award a low value contract for “**Curriculum Vitae (CV) data analytics & intelligence**”.

The maximum duration of the above-mentioned contract will be **12 months** from its signature. The maximum budget foreseen for this contract is **EUR 45,000** (excluding VAT) for the whole duration of the contract.

The scope of the project is to analyse the content of the ca 10 million anonymised CV gathered in the period 2015-2020 through the Europass CV editor.

The aim is to extract, through Data analysis and Machine learning, the structured information on the Occupations, Skills and Qualifications from the free text entries inside the CVs. Standard EU and international classification should be used: ESCO, ISCO, O*NET, EQF and ISCED¹.

Expected results include: (a) analysis of trends in occupations, qualifications and skills; (b) visualisation and presentation of these results in an interactive user-friendly web interface.

Description of the procurement procedure

The purpose of this ‘ex-ante publicity’ is to invite tenderers to express their interest in this procurement procedure.²

² Cedefop can accept offers from and sign contracts with tenderers from 37 countries, namely: the 27 EU Member States, the UK (during the transition phase currently ending on 31/12/2020), 3 EEA Countries (Liechtenstein, Norway, Iceland) and 6 SAA Countries (North Macedonia, Albania, Serbia, Montenegro, Bosnia & Herzegovina and Kosovo).

Candidates may choose between:

- submitting a joint offer as a consortium/grouping; or
- introducing a bid as a single tenderer.

In both cases, there is a possibility of having one or several subcontractors.

At this stage, the reply form attached has to be filled in only by the candidate (acting on behalf of a consortium or subcontractor).
