


Algorithmic recommendation of workers

Meet Julia


- A 29 year old Italian

'I don't need certification because it's just, actually, it's just a paper. But at the end, you, you pay, for example, forty or sixty pounds to get a paper saying that you attended the course online, so, but it's not very useful, I think.'



Digital (micro)credentials: a new passport



Micro-credentialism in EU+ job markets

- 38% of EU+ workers mainly did online education and training
- 69% of them earned an officially recognised qualification by national authority or other online certificate/digital online badge as visual token of person's learning




Microcredentials: better skills matching?



Digital microcredentials are earned mostly by Southern European workers but also those in mature VET systems





