Over 10 million Europass CVs generated online

The use of Europass documents has far surpassed expectations, confirming the relevance of this initiative to learners and workers in Europe. By October 2010 more than 10 million CVs had been created online. That is **seven million more than the target** of 3 million Europass documents by 2010 set by Commissioner Ján Figel'.

From the outset, Cedefop has been closely involved in preparing and implementing Europass. The initiative is part of a series of complementary European tools, all of which Cedefop has made considerable contributions to, including the European Qualifications Framework (EQF) and the European credit system for vocational education and training (ECVET). The development of these common European tools has been the result of the enhanced cooperation in vocational education and training between the European Commission, Member States and social partners, over the past eight years.
