**DECISION OF THE GOVERNING BOARD ON THE EXTENSION OF THE
MEDIUM-TERM PRIORITIES 2012-14 FOR ONE MORE YEAR UNTIL 2015**

Having regard to:

- the proposal by the Commission and the recommendation of the Bureau at its meeting of 28 February 2014;
- the ongoing review of the Europe 2020 strategy for smart, sustainable and inclusive growth
- the on-going mid-term review of the ET 2020, the strategic framework for European cooperation on education and training and within this process the ongoing consultations on defining priorities and short term deliverables for European VET policy under the Bruges Communiqué
- the upcoming European elections in May 2014 and formation of a new European Commission;
- the presently developed new format for multiannual programming and planning as requested by the new financial rules, applicable from 1.01.2016;

Whereas,

- the medium-term priorities 2012-14 seem fitting as a comprehensive framework for the next work programme (2015); and
- as it is for the Governing Board to adopt Cedefop's medium-term priorities;

THE GOVERNING BOARD OF CEDEFOP HAS DECIDED AS FOLLOWS:

Article 1

Cedefop's medium term priorities 2012-14 shall be extended for another year (2015) and, thus, will also provide the framework for planning the work programme 2015.

Article 2

This decision shall enter into force on the date of its signature.
