#### Focus of the December 2018 seminar

This seminar will provide an opportunity to reflect on the current and future role played by European VET in a time characterised by changing demographics, technologies and labour markets. Based on the extensive research carried out by Cedefop between 2015 and 2018, a set of scenarios will be presented, pointing the possible directions VET may take in the coming decades. The purpose of the scenarios is not to predict the future, but rather to alert policy makers and stakeholders on main trends and the possible implications of their policy choices.
