DECISION OF THE MANAGEMENT BOARD AMENDING FINANCING DECISION 2020

THE MANAGEMENT BOARD OF CEDEFOP

Having regard to the Regulation (EU) 2019/128 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 16 January 2019 establishing a European Centre for the Development of Vocational Training (Cedefop) and repealing Council Regulation (EEC) No 337/75;

Having regard to the Financial Regulation of Cedefop adopted by the GB on 16 July 2019 (RB(2019)1034), hereafter referred to as 'Financial Regulation';

Having regard to the Programming Document 2020-2022 of Cedefop approved by its Management Board on 19 December 2019, and in particular to the Work Programme 2020 and its Annex IX, establishing the main procurement activities for the year 2020 and the global budgetary envelope for procurements and grants;

Having regard to the flexibility clause included in Annex IX of the Work Programme 2020, which defines that non-substantial changes to the initial indicative procurement activities are approved by the Authorising Officer i.e. the Executive Director;

Whereas:

- 1. Article 72(2) of the Financial Regulation provides that the annual work programme of Cedefop is equivalent to a financing decision, for activities funded by its operational appropriations (i.e. Title 3), provided that elements set out in Article 32(2) and (3) of the same rules are identified;
- The multi-annual work programme of Cedefop incorporates the elements of Article 32(2), i.e. detailed objectives, expected results, and performance indicators, as well as indicative financial and human resources necessary to attain objectives set and contribute to achievement of EU political priorities;

- In line with Article 32(3) of the FR, the annual work programme of Cedefop sets out expected outputs which contribute directly to objectives set in the strategic programming, and a description of activities financed, together with an indication of financial and human resources allocated to each activity;
- 4. The same Article 32(3) of the FR provides that any substantial amendment to the annual work programme shall be adopted by the same procedure as the initial work programme;
- 5. Operational departments realigned their procurement plans to the actual needs, as the year evolved, and priorities reconsidered;
- 6. The initial budgetary envelope for procurements and grants was 5,923,800 EUR. The changes of planned individual activities' have a cumulative effect of 4,065,300 EUR, mainly fuelled by the change in the planned procurement envelope for the development of the Web Intelligence Hub for online job advertisement data (joint project and procurement procedure with Eurostat for 3 million EUR), and the downsizing of the 3rd Survey for VET and adult learning;
- 7. The cumulative changes represent a value of 68% of the initial budget allocated to procurements and grants. The cumulative effect constitutes a substantial change in the global budgetary envelop. Consequently, Annex IX of the Work Programme 2020 needs to amended;

HAS DECIDED AS FOLLOWS:

An amendment to the procurement plan for the year 2020, published in Annex IX of the Work Programme 2020, which constitutes part of the Programming Document 2020-2022, is adopted, as per Annex I to this decision.

This decision shall enter into force on the day of its signature.
