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# PROBLEMS WHICH ROMANIAN LABOUR MARKET HAS TO FACE NOWADAYS

- ✓ **High rates of migration for labour abroad**
- ✓ **Low unemployment rates**
- ✓ **Co-existence of deficits and surpluses**
- ✓ **Developments gaps between regions, as well as between urban and rural**
- ✓ **Economic growth based on the expansion of real estates and constructions**
- ✓ **Consequence: more focus on skills shortage as “labour shortage”**

# DESIGN OF THE METHODOLOGY

**Objective:** *to provide the key decision makers with an in-depth and comprehensive assessment of the labour demand in occupational profile on the Romania labour market.*

**Type of survey:** ad-hoc

**Statistical population:** active companies with 1 employee and more , covering all NACE sectors (except public administration)

**Statistical unit:** legal unit

**Sample size:** 1150 companies

**Methods and techniques:**

- Questionnaire-based survey. Face-to-face interviews carried out at the companies' headquarters with representatives of the top and middle management (heads of human resources departments and technical managers)
