Would you like to get first-hand knowledge and experience on education and vocational training themes of common interest in another country?

Then the **EU** **STUDYVISITS** programme is for you!

The Study Visits Programme is an EU programme for decision makers and specialists in education and vocational training. It gives you the chance to go on a short visit of 3-5 days to one of 31 European countries to learn about a specific aspect of lifelong learning. You will become familiar with successful policy initiatives and examples of good practice in other countries and meet your peers from all over Europe. You will be able to use the outcomes of the visit in your everyday work and establish new contacts.

Who can apply?

Being a member of trade unions or employer organisations, you are invited to apply. Participants are also chosen from among company training managers, small and medium-size enterprises (SMEs), shop stewards, representatives of the chambers and economic organisations of participating countries, directors of private training centres and others.

What themes can you explore?

- Improving access, equity, quality and efficiency in education and training
- Education and training for employability
- Implementation of common European tools, principles and frameworks for lifelong learning
- Trends and challenges in lifelong learning strategies

Where can you go?

Study visits take place in the 27 EU Member States, Iceland, Liechtenstein, Norway and Turkey.

What will it cost?

You will get a grant for your travel and per diem costs from your national agency.

How can you apply?

You need to complete an application form online.

In which language are visits held?

Study visits are offered in English, French, German and Spanish.
