REQUEST FOR CLARIFICATION (2) – QUESTIONS & ANSWERS

Question Nr. 1

I'm about to prepare a proposal for your open call for tenders "Unitisation and modularisation for flexibility and mobility in VET" and thereby came up the question about the phrase "Declares the intention to be at the Tenderer/Contractor's disposal for the performance of the contract, undertaking to contribute with (to be filled in).....% of the work by value." in your Letter of Intent. Could you please explain, what exactly is meant by this phrase?

Cedefop's clarification to Question Nr. 1

The letter of intent is applicable only in cases of subcontracting. Tenderers that intend to use the services of one or more subcontractors, in case of contract award, should therefore calculate the contribution of each subcontractor compared to the total work by value, and have the subcontractor concerned fill-in and sign the form in Annex J. Total work by value means the complete offer in Euro or the total number of person-days in order to complete the project as requested.
