Under the supervision of a Cedefop expert, you will work on state-of-the-art empirical analysis which links organisational characteristics to skills development and utilisation and explore the mechanisms and channels linking skills and organisational success. As such analysis is grounded in several disciplines (organisational psychology, sociology, educational sciences, economics, management sciences) the project is multidisciplinary in nature.

All syntax files used for the data manipulation and the empirical analyses with the required documentation of the analytical choices (for the purpose of replicability of the analysis)
