Producing single-skin building structures



Carrying out simple construction work according to instructions. Building simple building structures from different materials and preparing mortar mixtures. Using standard machines and appliances to do so.

Development of buildings



Setting up and securing the construction site. Following instructions to make the site ready for building and digging construction pits. Using the standard measuring instruments. Producing simple formwork and concrete and steel building parts.

Building structures with a supporting function

Constructing building structures with a supporting function according to instructions. Using the correct bond and the right mortar mixture when working with different stone formats and wall thicknesses. Dividing stones with machines and erecting simple scaffolding.

Sealing and insulating buildings

Choosing suitable insulating materials, cutting them to size and installing them. Taking into account the behavior of different building materials and creating seals according to instructions.

Conducting simple finishing works




Conducting simple finishing work. Covering building parts with tiles, erecting drywall building structures, preparing different types of plaster and processing screed.

Producing special structures and exposed masonry

Creating double-skin masonry with exposed masonry with a decorative bond. Covering openings in the masonry with a lintel. Creating and renovating simple steps, edging and infills (timber frames).

Notes on test content

The test consists of 100 questions on typical practical on-the-job situations. At least 20 questions are posed in a closed question format, per field of expertise. The test may take up to 4 hours. The test was developed by experts in various fields. The sub-division into various fields of expertise is oriented along the curricular content of the professional education and training, as well as occupational situations in practice. Practical job situations are represented via text, pictures and videos.

Notes on the interpretation of the results

The test covers practical professional knowledge, by posing questions regarding typical onthe-job situations and challenges.

This cannot be tested:

- Practical application and methodological competence
- Problem-solving skills
- Motivation, self-motivation and/or social skills
- · German language skills





Costs of validation

- Both tools free of charge to the candidate
- My-professional-experience.org
 - Development: ca. 400 k Euro (IT-platform, photos, translations, quality assurance, PM)
 - No license but freely accessible via PC, Smartphone and Tablet
- MYSKILLS:
 - Development: ca. 10 Mio. Euro, ~250 k per occupation, min. 50 k per additional language
 - License: ~50 € per test in foreign countries
 - Test execution: ~200 € per test
 - Guidance before and after are part of PES standard work
 - Hosting costs come on top, depends on many factors

Lessons Learned



- Modular approach creates added value
- Development costs are significant
- Translations of professional terms need QA
- Pictures and videos often need to be made instead of taken from photo-stocks
- Scalability depends on a good roll-out strategy and a strong partner to implement it
- Validity, reliability & transferability is possible
