Event code of conduct - Notice to participants

Additionally, the organisers reserve the right to ban a participant or observer from the proceedings of an event and/or of subsequent events and remove her/his contributions from all platforms, if their oral, visual, textual or other contribution can be considered as, *inter alia*:

- False and/or slanderous claims
- Harassment, hate, cruel and/or insensitive speech
- Infringement of privacy, intellectual property rights, consumer protection and/or cybersecurity
- Spam and/or false news
- Fraud and deception
- Inauthentic behaviour and/or impersonation
- Incitement to violence and/or terrorism
- Violent, graphic, pornographic and/or child sexual abuse material
- Coordinating to cause harm and publicising crime

The above is an indicative list without limitation and shall also include, bearing the same sanctions, any content that may be construed as being in breach of the laws and recommendations of the European Union and its Member States or international conventions and best practice.
