

Understanding public opinion on Vocational Education and Training (VET)



120 - 20 cognitive interviews in 6 EU countries to test and improve the question-

- 30 interviews conducted in each EU Member State to pilot the survey (test the questionnaire and the infrastructure)



Language and conceptualisation issues

35,646 interviews conducted in total – with up to 2,200 interviews conducted in a single country















CONCEPTUALISATION IN PRACTICE: WHAT IS VET FOR?



% of people who were given information about VET when making decisions














Would you say VET has a positive image in your country?
















Understanding public opinion on Vocational Education and Training (VET)
