



How to Move









keeping the **SPACEBAR** key pressed.

How to



By default scrolling zooms and pressing Snift and scrolling pans. If you'd prefer, you can pan by default and press Shift to zoom. Uncheck the "Scroll to Zoom" in the zoom menu.




SHIFT + Mouse Wheel/Scroll: Press and hold the **SHIFT** key while using the mouse wheel or scroll motion on the trackpad to zoom in and out of the board.






Option 2, Mouse Wheel/Scroll + Minimap: Hover over the minimap and use the mouse wheel or scroll motion on the trackpad to zoom in and out of the board.




Option 4, Zoom tool (Z): Select the Zoom tool from the toolbar. Click and drag a selection to zoom in to an area. Press **SHIFT** and click, to zoom back out, or use the mouse wheel/ scroll motion directly in the board to zoom in and out.

How to Move




Select Tool (S): Switch to the Select tool, then click on an item. Use the blue cross to move the item. Some items are pinned, please leave them as pinned to keep the workspace.




When you have selected an item or multiple items, new options will appear in the toolbar. You can group, align, scale, move to front/back, delete, etc.
