He obtained his university diploma at Janus Pannonius University in Pecs as teacher of Hungarian Literature and Linguistics and Aesthetics in 1989; later gained a post graduate diploma at Corvinus University, Budapest, as Labor Relations expert in 2006.

He is an expert of Training and Labor relations of the Hungarian Democratic League of Independent Trade Unions from 1991. He plans and organizes the national level training courses of his organization.

In 1996 he participated in a trainee program of European Trade Union Confederation for 4 months at Technical Assistance Unit. He engaged responsibility for co-ordination of National Integration Committees regarding the accession of the Eastern European Countries.

In 2007-2008 as guest lecturer in Szent István University, Jászberény taught European Studies, and wrote several studies from organizing issues to European VET policy. From this time he is the chief editor of LIGA Trade Union information booklets and materials.

In 2009-2011 he was responsible for shaping the vocational training policy of LIGA Trade Union in close cooperation of Hungarian Industrial and Commerce Association and coordinated the LIGA's members of Regional Training and Development Committees.
