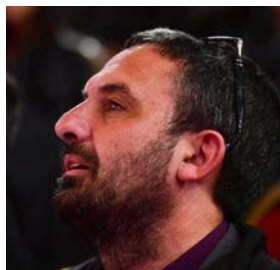


PERSONAL INFORMATION
