1) specifics of providing career guidance in KCV

- since 2015 with the support of the Labor Office of the Czech Republic in Pilsen <u>supporting the employability of the citizens</u> of the Pilsen Region thru career guidance
- <u>supporting schools</u> in implementing career management skills in the curriculum and supporting career guidance counseling for pupils/students
- close participation in building <u>strategic documents</u> in a lifelong learning area

(2011 – 2013 Grundtvig) Professional Development of Basic Skills Trainers – career guidance basics

(2012-2013 ESF - Global Grants of Pilsen Region) Information and counseling center for lifelong learning — <u>building professional</u> <u>capacities for career guidance counseling in lifelong learning + building a network of partners</u>





Building physical space

(2012-2015 Ministry for Regional Development EU funding) - Information and counseling center for lifelong learning - renovation of the building for career guidance counseling and lifelong learning support





NO External funding in 2015 – 2018







Implementation of the Regional action plan

2018-2020 – <u>supporting career guidance in secondary schools</u>, <u>supporting the transfer from primary to secondary schools</u>

2021-2023 – <u>a creation of a career counseling network – mapping</u> and networking of career guidance and lifelong learning support <u>services in the Pilsen region</u>





The main goal of the cooperation is to connect and support social partners so that they cooperate and build quality and widely available services.

quality = clearly presented, professional services

accessibility = in every microregion, for free

1) Communication platforms for each subtheme of lifelong learning (a group of the main stakeholders in the target area) e.g career guidance, career development

Based on one-year cooperation with the main stakeholders in education and supporting services Pilsen region created The Vision of education in the Pilsen region in 2035.







In conclusion

The continuity of lifelong guidance policy is based on the intensive discussion of social partners and anchoring the cooperation results in strategic documents.

Limited promotion of lifelong guidance to the public, the inclusion of only partial topics of lifelong guidance in strategic documents, and funding relying too much on external sources is a space for discontinuity.
