| WHAT THE TRAINEESHIP IS ABOUT | |
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| Department / Service | Department for VET systems and institutions (DSI) |
| Project description | <p>Learning providers and Mobility scoreboard content support</p> <p>The department for VET systems and institutions supports policy development and provides evidence for policy making to help modernise vocational education and training (VET) systems.</p> <p>This work requires collaborating with colleagues in house and external partners, for instance the European Commission, national ministries, employer and employee representatives and learning providers.</p> <p>The <u>European community of learning providers</u> was set up in February 2017 by Cedefop and six EU-level VET associations (EfVET, EVBB, EVTA, EUCEN, EUproVET and EURASHE) in order to complement the Platform for European associations of VET providers created by DG EMPL in 2015 which provides policy advice to the EU Commission.</p> <p>The community's objectives include deeper cooperation, mutual learning, selection of good practices, and production of concrete practical guidance on priority themes. Its ultimate goal is to help the VET provider community prepare for future challenges and increase the impact of EU-level cooperation on VET.</p> <p>The methodological approach of the community uses learning providers' priorities and practical experience as a starting point. For the 2017-20 period three themes were agreed to be worked on in the following three parallel working groups: (a) the challenge of technology-enhanced learning (TEL), (b) EU mobility and (c) migration.</p> <p>The work requires support to the working groups in formulating their suggestions and recommendations to allow the European Commission to take them into account in its 2020 reporting exercise.</p> <p>The <u>IVET mobility scoreboard</u> is a tool for monitoring developments in IVET mobility policies and the implementation of the 2011 Council recommendation 'Youth on the move' in European countries.</p> <p>The scoreboard is a mechanism for assisting policy-making in international learning mobility.</p> |

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| | <p>The database provides detailed country information on the conditions for IVET learner mobility in Europe: analysing weaknesses and shortcomings; identifying good practices; and suggesting reforms. It addresses 10 key action areas.</p> <p>The mobility scoreboard for initial VET is based on country information provided by ReferNet and validated by country representatives. The work requires support to the updating the database.</p> |
