The trainee's main duties and tasks	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Data extractions and data validation;• Assessing quality and comparability of figures, based on data and metadata analysis;• Prepare figures and tables;• Draft short text on the main findings;• Preparing datasets for empirical analysis (e.g. EULFS, EUSILC, PIAAC, ECS);• Engage in dataset merging and data cleaning;• Derive descriptive statistics and engage in multivariate analysis of key variables of interest related to education, skills and related working conditions and management practices.

ESSENTIAL REQUIREMENTS	
Academic background	The trainee must have demonstrable skills in data handling and statistical analysis (e.g. an undergraduate or Master's degree in Statistics, Economics or Econometrics) and some past experience in preparing and cleaning international datasets using standard statistical software (working knowledge of either SPSS, SAS, STATA or equivalent is a pre-requisite).
