	 newer one on Empowering Young NEETs: Support the work of the team by undertaking preliminary research on related themes, to enrich the resources of the toolkits, especially on the role of VET to support young NEETs developing digital and green skills. Analyse existing Cedefop research and findings to populate the toolkits. Review the newly uploaded content and
	 regularly test the appropriate functioning of the tools to ensure user-friendliness. Prepare brief messages and content for dissemination through Cedefop social media and other appropriate dissemination channels in collaboration with the Team Facilitator and the communication's department of Cedefop. Assist in preparation of visually attractive presentations and create graphic materials to be used in different presentations/events.
