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## Evaluation and monitoring of certification

- the purpose of evaluation and monitoring is to improve the quality of VET;
- sometimes data that is collected is not used;
- data is collected to be used by the system and VET providers, and to support management;
- understand why data is not used and change what you collect or how you collect it;
- combine qualitative and quantitative data;



## Evaluation and monitoring of certification

- be clear about the balance and purpose of internal and external processes;
- address fraud, corruption and identity theft;
- sometimes the processes are about international quality e.g. sector based certification;
- data from monitoring and evaluation comes from learners, VET schools, employers and stakeholders;
- be clear about what is part of general quality assurance and what is specific to the certification process;
- indicators matter e.g. what does high drop-out show?



## 'Solutions'

- ensure assessment is not based on one person's view e.g. team teaching or three people panels;
- VET providers and the system needs comparable and reliable data to use as the basis to enhance quality;
- does it help to create a connection between the quality of provision as measured by indicators and funding;
- senior managers are involved in assessments to ensure they experience how things currently work;
- in-depth 'nose-to-tail' reviews of a learner's experience of a specific qualification can be illuminating;
- be very clear that information from the monitoring and evaluation of the certification processes will be used to improve the quality of VET provision.
