



## PRACTICAL INFORMATION

### AT YOUR ARRIVAL IN PARIS' AIRPORT

#### To and from the Charles de Gaulle Airport

Participants should make their own transportation arrangements from Charles de Gaulle International Airport to their hotel and UNESCO. The journey to UNESCO and surrounding hotels will take approximately 45-60 minutes in normal traffic. Participants can choose from the following traffic options:

- **Roissybus**, a special bus service that links the Charles de Gaulle airport and "Opera" in Paris. Buses come every 15 – 20 minutes at a price of €10. From "Opera", you can take the Paris Metro. - **RER B** (2 stations within the airport zone: Charles de Gaulle airport 1, and Charles de Gaulle airport 2 - TGV). You may also notice the term "Roissy-Rail"; this is sometimes used to name the part of the RER B line between Paris Gare du Nord and the Charles de Gaulle airport. Travel time : approximately 25 minutes to the Gare du Nord. Train intervals: 10 - 15 minutes on weekdays. Price: €9.50. - A **metered taxi** from the airport to the vicinity of UNESCO: approx. €50-60

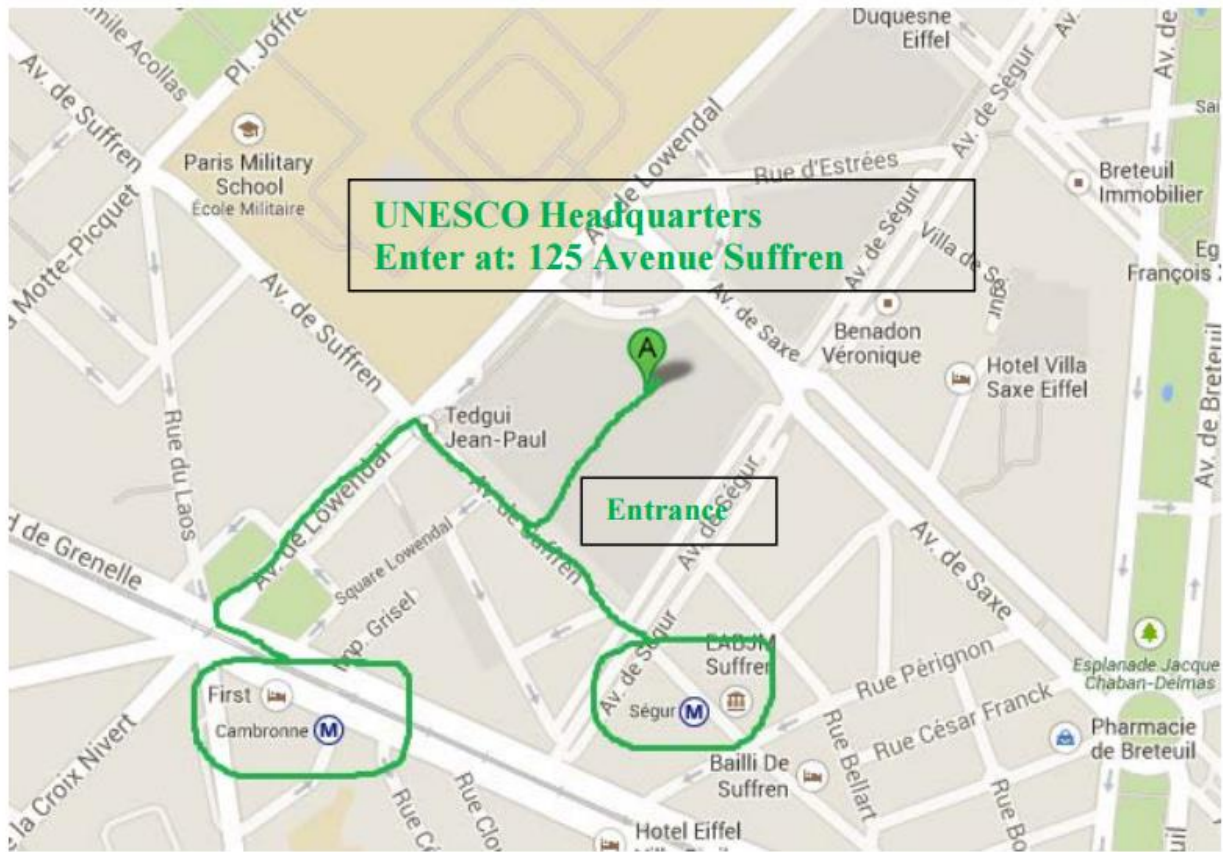

##### **Metro:**

The closest metro stops to UNESCO are Cambronne or Sèvres-Lecourbe (Line 6) and Ségur (Line 10).

### BANK SERVICE

**Société Générale**: UNESCO has its own Bank service in both buildings: Fontenoy and Miollis.

The Bank opens from 9:30 p.m. to 12:15 a.m. and from 1.15 p.m. to 5.15 p.m. There is a cash withdrawal machine available open at all times.
