Professor Dimitrios V. He is a member of various research organisations and think tanks, such as the Association of Greek Public Law Experts, the Hellenic Association of Regional Scientists, the Hellenic Association of Political Scientists, and, in the past, the European Law Institute at the University of Durham, the Political Research Centre at Panteion University, etc. He has served as member of the Education Committee of the Council of Ministers of the European Union, member of the Governing Body of the European Centre for the Development of Vocational Training (CEDEFOP), member at the Greek Monitoring Team on the Lisbon Strategy and member of the Monitoring Committee of the Community Support Framework as well as of various Operational Programmes in Greece. He is an Honorary Fellow of the Association of Fellows and Legal Scholars of the Center for International Legal Studies, Salzburg (Austria).
