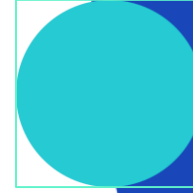

THE AIM

Demonstrate the individual level of skills, rigor and mastery of techniques and tools for the exercise of each skill / profession in the competition

Evaluate the effectiveness of VET provided by the different operators

Increase quality, innovation and creativity in the teaching-learning processes

ORGANIZATION

Institute for Employment and Vocational Training promotes, organizes and carries out all activities related to the Skills Skills Championships in Portugal and participation in international championships

They take place every 2 years, rotating between the different regions of the country

Parallel events: Seminars; Training events; Demonstration of new equipment

Competitions addressed at young people between the ages of 17 and 22/29 who have completed or are currently studying for a qualification in vocational education and training

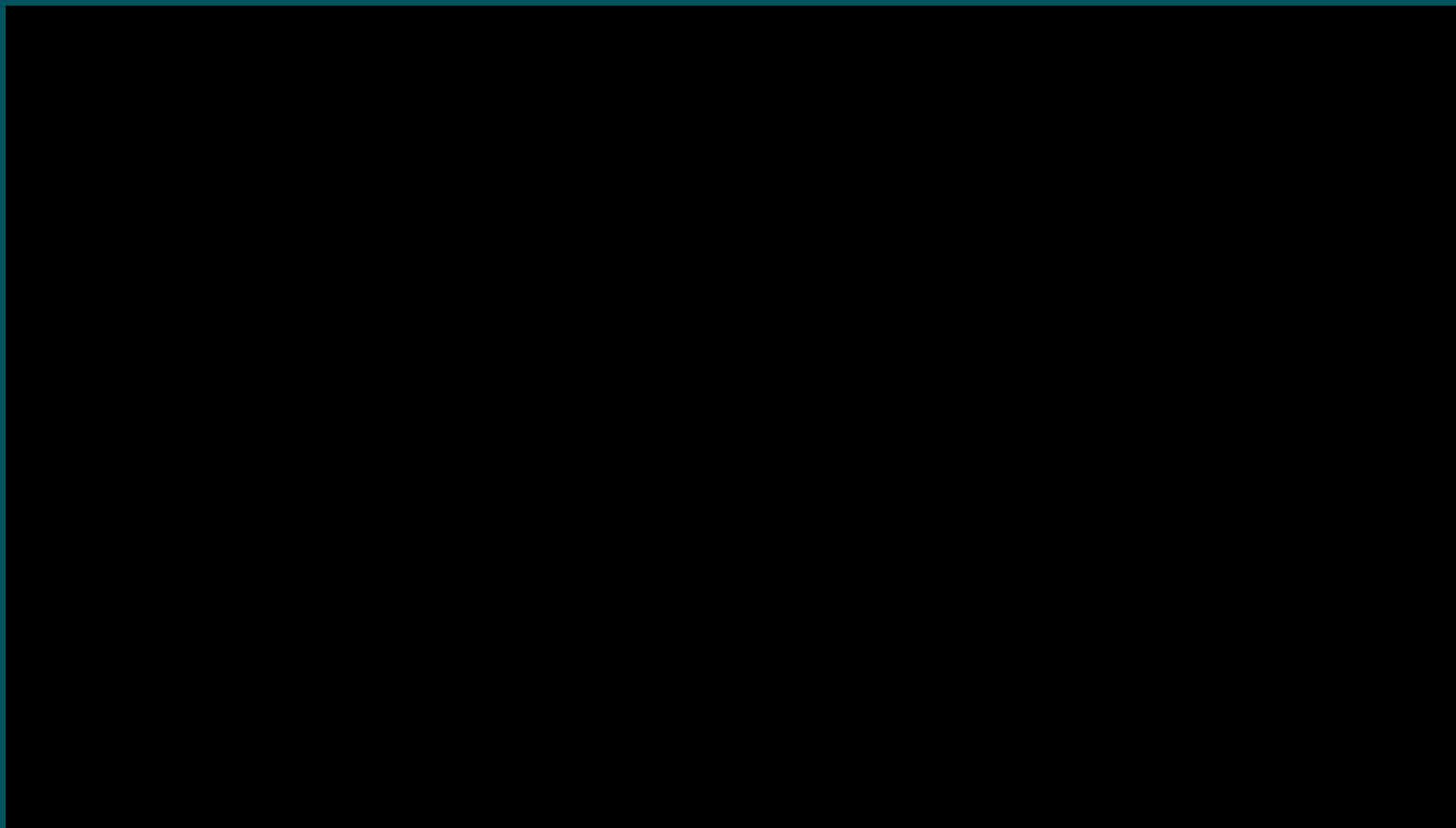

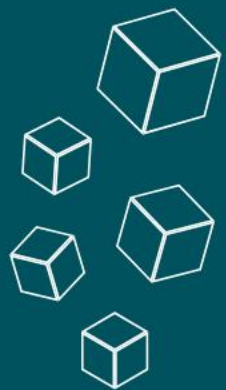

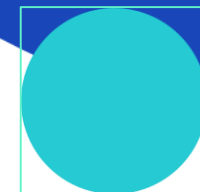
