

Privacy Statement on the protection of personal data in relation to Cedefop's activity "Supporting Slovenia to set up a Skills Forecast and Skills Governance system"

Online survey among skills governance stakeholders – Slovenia

Personal data are processed by Cedefop in accordance with the provisions of Regulation (EU) 2018/1725¹ of the European Parliament and of the Council of 23 October 2018 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data by the Union institutions, bodies, offices and agencies and on the free movement of such data.

Identity of controller:

Cedefop (Department for VET and Skills)

Processor:

Cedefop team supporting Slovenia in setting up a skills governance system

Purpose of the processing:

To gather information on what types and sources of skills information respondents use in their work, how they perceive current skills governance arrangements in Slovenia and what ideas they have for strengthening skills intelligence in the near future.

Description of the processing:

The Slovenian Ministry of Labour, Family, Social Affairs and Equal Opportunities is organising an event on the above topic in July 2022. Cedefop will be responsible for developing and analysing an online questionnaire in which personal data will be collected. The Slovenian Ministry will be responsible for administering it to stakeholders in their country. Cedefop will be presenting anonymised key findings from the questionnaire during the event.

Processor:

Slovenian Ministry of Labour, Family, Social Affairs and Equal Opportunities

Categories of personal data processed:

The survey is anonymous. The data collected include: type of respondent's employer. Respondents are not required to provide other personal details that could allow their identification.

Legal basis:

Cedefop's Programming Document. The lawfulness of the processing is based on article 5(1)(a) in that processing is necessary for the performance of a task carried out in the public interest or in the exercise of official authority vested in the Union institution or body; and (d) (where consent required) of Regulation (EU) 2018/1725.

Recipients of the data processed:

Cedefop staff (or external auditing bodies) involved in the evaluation, audit or other required follow-up on this event.

Retention period of the collected personal data

Data will be kept by Cedefop until the completion of the activity and follow up actions. Fully anonymised micro-data may be kept by Cedefop for a longer period for research purposes.

Data subject's rights:

Data subjects have the right to request access to, rectification of, and erasure of their personal data. If processing is based on consent, this consent can be withdrawn at any time.
