He also provided technical assistance to the Ministry of Social Security and Labour and the Ministry of Education and Science, and was a key executive in the work related to the Lithuanian vocational training institutions network restructuring and development (2007-2013).

Since the beginning of 2019, Marius, working as an expert in the Center for the Development of Qualifications and Vocational Education and Training, is focusing on the issues of recognizing the competences acquired by professionals and the external evaluation / supervision of the quality of VET activities. Since March 2019, Marius is the Chairman of the Human Resources Working Group (under the Ministry of Economy and Innovations of the Republic of Lithuania; the composition and functions of group members is approved by the order of the Minister) of the National Industry Digitalization Platform preparing for Industry 4.0 Revolution.
